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ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The abstract must be informative, including a statement of the study's specific objectives, methods, summary of the results and concluding statement. The abstract handling committee (i.e. the co-chairmen and members of the International Advisory Board) will notify the authors regarding abstract acceptance and the form of presentation. **The abstracts will be published in the abstract e-book of the 17th Dresden Symposium on Autoantibodies.**
